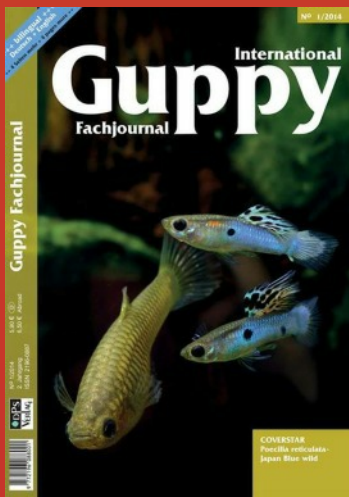

I.K.G.H. Guppy Clubs vote on Judging changes.

Changes to female Points

Eddy Vanvoorden IKGH.

Outlined in his Guppy Manifesto sent out in November 2013. Available for all Guppy Breeders to view on the I.K.G.H. Web site. The Female Points awarded when evaluating the I.K.G.H Pairs is not fit for purpose.

I personally have often thought when Judging that 20 points to evaluate the female and then award 50 points thereafter seemed the wrong way to evaluate the Female Guppy in detail. I.K.G.H. Clubs have been asked to consider a suggestion for change that may well take effect in 2014.

The present system has a maximum value of points for the Pair set at 170 points. 100 points to the male and 70 points to the female. Only 20 points of the females total points are used to evaluate her and 50 points are awarded automatically.

Eddy in consultation with other prominent I.K.G.H.Judges is now asking for this to be reviewed.

The suggestion is total points for the Pair . If this is accepted are maximum of 150 Points. The Male will still be evaluated the same 100 Points and the Female 50 Points as shown below.
